

Sample of a 16-day music tour



Day 1 - Arrival in Prague

Arrival in Prague. Meeting the tour escort / guide, and the van to carry the instruments during the entire tour. Night walk to a lookout tower.

Day 2 - Prague

Morning guided walking tour of the Castle District, then over the Charles Bridge finishing in the Old Town. Rehearsal in St Nicholas Church in the Old Town. Optionally: The band does some busking in the Old Square beforehand to publicize the concert. Concert in St Nicholas Church. Free time in the Old Town. Dinner at U Fleku Pub (very old and famous) before returning to the hotel.



Day 3 - Prague

Free time, shopping OR visiting a local music school, interaction with students OR visiting the Prague Music Museum and/or Dvořák Museum. Evening at Prague Opera (attendance) or other program (Black Light Theatre, etc.)

Day 4 - Prague to Salzburg

Transfer from Prague to Salzburg via Cesky Krumlov (with a short walking tour and free time). Arrival in Salzburg in the evening.



Day 5 - Salzburg

Guided walking tour (including Mozart's House of Birth) Concert in Mirabell Garden. Free time, then returning to the hotel. Classical Mozart concert attendance at Mirabell palace.

Day 6 - Salzburg to Vienna

Early departure for the transfer to Vienna. Stop and visit at the Salt mines in Hallein. Arrival in Vienna late afternoon.

Day 7 - Vienna

Morning city tour in Vienna. Afternoon: visit the Schönbrunn Palace. Optionally: short singing on the steps, outdoor concert OR Concert at the Votive Church

Day 8 - Vienna

Visit at Wiener Musikverein (Golden Hall) + Haus der Musik OR visit at a local music school with workshop. Afternoon free for shopping. Heuriger (typical) dinner in restaurant with live music.



Day 9 - Vienna to Budapest

Early transfer to Budapest. En route visit and concert in the magnificent Haydn Hall in the Esterhazy Palace in Fertőd (where Haydn worked for a long time). Afternoon rehearsal and concert in the palace, invited guests: students from the local music school. Late afternoon we continue to Budapest.

Day 10 - Budapest

Full day city tour, with focus on music (visiting the Liszt Museum, and the Opera house). Optional rehearsal in the hotel that afternoon. Evening at the Hungarian State Opera (attendance).

Day 11 - Kecskemét (one day trip)

Arrival in Kecskemét in the morning (home of the Kodály-method). Visit at the Kodály Music School, (have a lesson / workshop with a maestro, singing together with local students) Concert in the main Concert Hall of the school. Afternoon: lunch and fun program with local students at a special Hungarian inn (Puszta Olympic Games - funny exercises in teams - only in good weather).

Day 12 - Budapest

Morning free, shopping or fun program (visiting the zoo, or hiking tour in the Buda hills). Rehearsal and concert in one of the concert halls / churches in Budapest. (Optional: joint concert with a Hungarian choir) Exclusive dinner cruise on the beautiful luminous River Danube.

Day 13 - Budapest to Venice

Departure to Venice. Arrival in the evening.

Day 14 - Venice

Full day city tour, lunch, dinner at the hotel.
Optionally evening rehearsal.

Day 15 - Venice

Rehearsal in the hotel, and lunch. Afternoon concert at St Mark Cathedral. The rest of the afternoon is free.

Day 16 - Departure

Breakfast at the hotel, then check out.
Transfer to the airport.
(or on demand continue to Rome or France)
